- 3 Submit through the [IEICE submission site](#) and select the exact options shown in the orange panel at right. Do not choose "[Regular-ED] Information and Systems" or any other special section.
- 4 This special section is operated under the ISS Symposium and Journal Dual Submission scheme, jointly with The 21st International Conference on Knowledge, Information and Creativity Support Systems (KICSS 2026), to be held November 19-21, 2026. Refer to the official [scheme submission guide](#) (Japanese).
- 5 Reviewing is conducted in a single-blind manner. Authors do not need to anonymize their manuscripts.
- 6 Authors must agree to the "Copyright Transfer and Page Charge Agreement" via electronic submission. The publication fee will be the responsibility of each author.

- Journal manuscript: same content as the KICSS 2026 submission, reformatted for IEICE
- Page count and layout may differ between versions
- Conference and journal reviews, schedules, and decisions are independent
